2017-2018 YEAR IN REVIEW

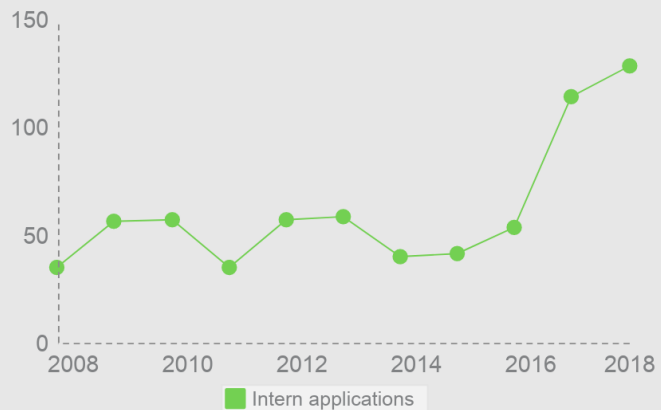


2017-2018 was a strong program year for Dartmouth Partners in Community Service Internships at the Dartmouth Center for Social Impact.
