2 - 4:30 pm: Baker Tower Bell Tours (at Baker Library Information Desk). Self-guided visit. 150 free tickets will be distributed beginning at 1:45 p.m. in numbered groups of 10. Groups will take the tour in order of their group number from 2-4:30 p.m. Each tour will take approximately 10 minutes to ascend, take in the beautiful views, and descend. This is a hands free experience – each person must be able to navigate many steep steps and a ladder on his/her own.

2 - 4 pm: Navigating College Admissions - Led by Lee Coffin, vice provost for enrollment and dean of admissions and financial aid, the case studies workshop introduces participants to the selective admissions process. Workshop participants will review aspects of sample college applications, engage in a discussion about the applications, and learn first-hand about the important factors that shape a student's candidacy. (Tickets cannot be ordered online. Tickets may be purchased by phone or in person after September 30th as well, but the Class of 85 block of tickets may no longer be available.)

To buy your tickets for Dartmouth Football at Yankee Stadium (and sit with other '85s):

Dartmouth's **Berry Sports Center Ticket Office** has placed a hold on a block of seats in Yankee Stadium for members of the Class of 1985 in **Section 111, Rows 15, 16 & 17, Seats 7-16**. Tickets there are "premium level" seating and are \$89 per person. (Tickets are also available in other sections of Yankee Stadium for \$59 per person or \$42 per person if you prefer, also via the link below.) The **deadline** for purchasing tickets within our Class of 1985 block is **October 4, 2019**.

To purchase tickets in this block, you have two options:

1. Dartmouth's Berry Sports Center Ticket Office has created an exclusive link for the Class of 1985 to purchase these tickets online. Click the link below to be taken to the ticket page, click on section 111 (you may want to zoom in with the magnifying glass icon in the top right) and select the seats you want to purchase. These seats are only available by using this link. Other visitors will not have access to them. [Class of 1985 Seating at Yankee Stadium](#).

2. Call the Dartmouth Ticket Office (603-646-2466) and ask to be seated in the Class of 1985 seats in section 111.
